 - Community sentiment = generally positive








Focus on: Seabed studies



Seabed studies

- Starting early 2023
- Studying seabed composition and strength
- 8-week duration
- Borehole sampling up to 70 m deep and 7 cm wide
- Cone penetration tests pressing a 10cm² steel cone into the seabed


