


Declaration of Bass Strait, off Gippsland

Area revised following government consultation in Aug-Sep 2022 – 765 submissions received.

Consultation overview and findings available online


Key changes:

- 10km coastal buffer
- Expands bird flyway passage between Wilsons Prom and Flinders Island
- Wider shipping lane
- Area west of the Prom not declared pending further consultation





Feasibility Licence applications open



Regulator

Design notification scheme

- · Provides for early engagement and feedback from the Regulator on design philosophy
- · Mandatory for all commercial projects
- · Voluntary for infrastructure under the research and demonstration and transmission and infrastructure streams

Management plan

Required before any infrastructure can be installed. Content will vary according to the licence/ infrastructure type and will cover:

- · Work, health and safety
- · Environmental management
- · Plans for construction, commissioning, operations, maintenance and decommissioning
- · Interaction and consultation with other marine users
- Decommissioning cost estimate

Revisions are required every 5 years or because of a change, or proposed change, of circumstances or operations

Financial security agreement

- · To be commensurate to the full cost of decommissioning installed infrastructure
- · Qantum, form and timing to be agreed by the Regulator

Major Project Status

"Major Project Status means the <u>Major Projects Facilitation</u>
<u>Agency</u> will provide bespoke, tailored facilitation, referral and information services to Star of the South for 3 years.

This includes understanding and navigating the Australian Government regulatory approvals process.

- development for regional and northern Australia"





2023 look ahead – key priorities

- Feasibility licence application TOP PRIORITY!
- Understanding and adapting to emerging policy and regulations
 - Victorian Offshore Wind Implementation Statements 1 (released), 2 (early 2023) and 3 (late 2023)
 - VicGrid-led transmission
 - Offshore Electricity Infrastructure Act draft second tranche of regulations expected in early 2023 and is expected to cover management plans, financial security, protection zones and work health and safety.
- Continuing work on and adapting our environmental assessments
- Continuing to work in partnership with locals, GLaWAC, landholders, government and industry
