Victoria sets offshore wind targets

Wind turbines could be spinning off Victoria's coast as early as 2028 with the Victorian Government recently announcing a plan to build at least 9GW of offshore wind by 2040. Victoria's offshore wind ambition is set out in the <u>Victorian Offshore Wind Policy Directions Paper</u>.

Offshore Electricity Infrastructure Act now in effect

The Offshore Electricity Infrastructure Act, which provides a pathway for offshore wind projects to be built and operated off the coast of Australia, came into effect in June 2022.

Gippsland first in line for offshore wind

Bass Strait off Gippsland is proposed to be the first area open to offshore renewable developments, including offshore wind. The Australian Government is <u>seeking feedback</u> on whether the proposed area is suitable for development. Consultation closes 7 October.

Supplier profile – Kiernan Plant Hire

Gippsland business Kiernan Plant Hire was subcontracted by Douglas Partners, to support ground investigations for Star of the South this year.

Kiernan Plant Hire is owned and operated by Mark and Jess who employ a growing team of thirteen.

Two of their team members dug around 150 'test pits' over 10 weeks so that soil and rock samples could be collected and tested to inform the design of our transmission system.





Connecting local suppliers with future opportunities

If Star of the South is approved and proceeds to construction, we'd procure around 10 major contracts for goods like turbines, cables and substations, and for services like marine installation and civil construction.

We'll expect our contractors to work with Gippsland and Victorian suppliers, Traditional Owner and Aboriginal-owned businesses, and social enterprises.

We've identified more than 100 goods and services that could be supplied locally.

Spence Consulting Group are kicking off a supply chain study on our behalf, to identify local opportunities and businesses that could support offshore wind projects. Businesses identified will be featured in an offshore wind supplier directory, showcasing local capabilities to the global offshore wind supply chain.
