



Gunaikurnai businesses and partners

The Gunaikurnai people are the Traditional Owners of much of Gippsland.

The Gunaikurnai Land and Waters Aboriginal Corporation (GLaWAC) is the Registered Aboriginal Party that represents the Gunaikurnai people, as determined by the Victorian Aboriginal Heritage Council under the Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006. GLaWAC was legally recognised by the Federal Court of Australia under the Traditional Owners Settlement Act 2010. GLaWAC offers several direct commercial services and has established partnerships with local businesses.

Cultural services and consulting – Under traditional laws and customs, Gunaikurnai people have a responsibility to welcome visitors to Country – by fire, smoke, water ceremonies and with other specific cultural details including language, customs, protocols, and dreaming stories. In addition to conducting traditional ceremonies, GLaWAC offers cultural education and awareness sessions, and cultural consultation services.

Cultural heritage protection - GLaWAC participates in the preparation of Cultural Heritage Management Plans (CHMPs) and evaluates plans prepared by its Cultural Heritage Advisors. It also advises state and local governments on applications for Cultural Heritage Permits, negotiates and enters into Cultural Heritage Agreements, and advises on and negotiates the repatriation of Aboriginal cultural heritage.

Land management services – GLaWAC's contract services team offers a range of services to protect Country, and support and empower the community, working with private businesses, partner agencies, community groups and landholders to deliver practical and insightful solutions to enhance the environment and support healthy Country. The team provides meaningful employment and training to Aboriginal people across Gippsland through learning, working, and caring for all aspects of Gunaikurnai land, waters and biodiversity. Services provided include:

- Revegetation and restoration projects
- Propagation and supply of native plants
- Pest plant and animal management
- Biodiversity monitoring
- Weed control

- Civil services
- Roadside management
- Machinery works
- Landscaping
- Site surveys.





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
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
